3. ORGANISATION BACKGROUND:

4. JOB DESCRIPTION/ RESPONSIBILITIES:

The **Community Resource Persons** shall be responsible for the following.

Key Job Responsibilities:

- (1) S/he will engage with the local community to create awareness of MGNREGA.
- (2) Facilitate active participation of the local community and build their ownership in the programme at all stages, such as planning, implementation and monitoring of work.
- (3) Mobilize community members to claim their right to employment and work towards creating durable assets.
- (4) Towards this, the Social Mobilizer would work to strengthen the community interface with the duty bearers of the Gram Panchayat.
- (5) Play active roles in conducting training, and exposure visits for the grass root stakeholders and helping the villagers to plan for sustainable livelihood interventions.
- (6) Set up systems and processes to enable the community to maintain physical structures created under the project.

5. QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND COMPETENCIES:

Qualification and Experience

Graduate in any discipline with one to two years of work experience in social mobilisation.

Matriculate with a minimum of two to five years of work experience in social mobilisation and natural resource management with the rural community at the grassroots.

Non-matriculate Community Resource Persons trained and guided by reputed NGOs / Institutions and have more than five years of work experience in SHG. Natural resource management may also be applicable.

- (1) Should be motivated to work in the villages, especially with deprived sections and willing to acquire new knowledge and skills relevant to the project and guide implementation processes.
- (2) Fluency to communicate in the local language.
- (3) Ability to work in a multi-cultural/ multi-disciplinary team.
- (4) Ability to multi-task and work well in such a team.
- (5) Willing to travel.
