2. ROLE DESCRIPTION:

BRLF would be implementing the project "Agroecology-based Regional Model Landscape Transformation (AgRMLT)" (hereinafter referred to as 'Project') in two blocks of Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh. The objective of the project is building an agroecology-based landscape collaborative governance model in two blocks of Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh. This project will be implemented in coordination with the Madhya Pradesh chapter of the National Coalition for Natural Farming (NCNF).

The Project Lead-District Consultant for the AgRMLT (Agroecology- based regional model landscape transformation) project under the Bharat Rural Livelihoods Foundation (BRLF) is responsible for managing and coordinating project activities at the district level. The project implemented by BRLF is in coalition with NCNF (National Coalition for Natural

Farming). Experience in managing district-level projects and working with diverse community stakeholders is essential.

- 4. Assist coalitions in establishing effective relationships with government machinery at district and block levels.
- 5. Support the agroecology and food systems development coalition in creating landscape-level action plans.
- 6. Facilitate meetings and capacity-building training programs for various stakeholders and partners.
- 7. Monitor progress and action plans and share updates periodically with coalition members.
- 8. Ensure effective coordination and communication with key stakeholders and governance structures at district and sub-district levels.
