2. ROLE DESCRIPTION:

BRLF would be implementing the project "Agroecology-based Regional Model Landscape Transformation (AgRMLT)" (hereinafter referred to as 'Project') in two blocks of Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh. The objective of the project is building an agroecology-based landscape collaborative governance model in two blocks of Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh. This project will be implemented in coordination with the Madhya Pradesh chapter of the National Coalition for Natural Farming (NCNF).

The Project Associate-Consultant for the project AgRMLT (Agroecology- based regional model landscape transformation) under the Bharat Rural Livelihoods Foundation (BRLF) plays a crucial role in supporting the effective implementation of project activities.
